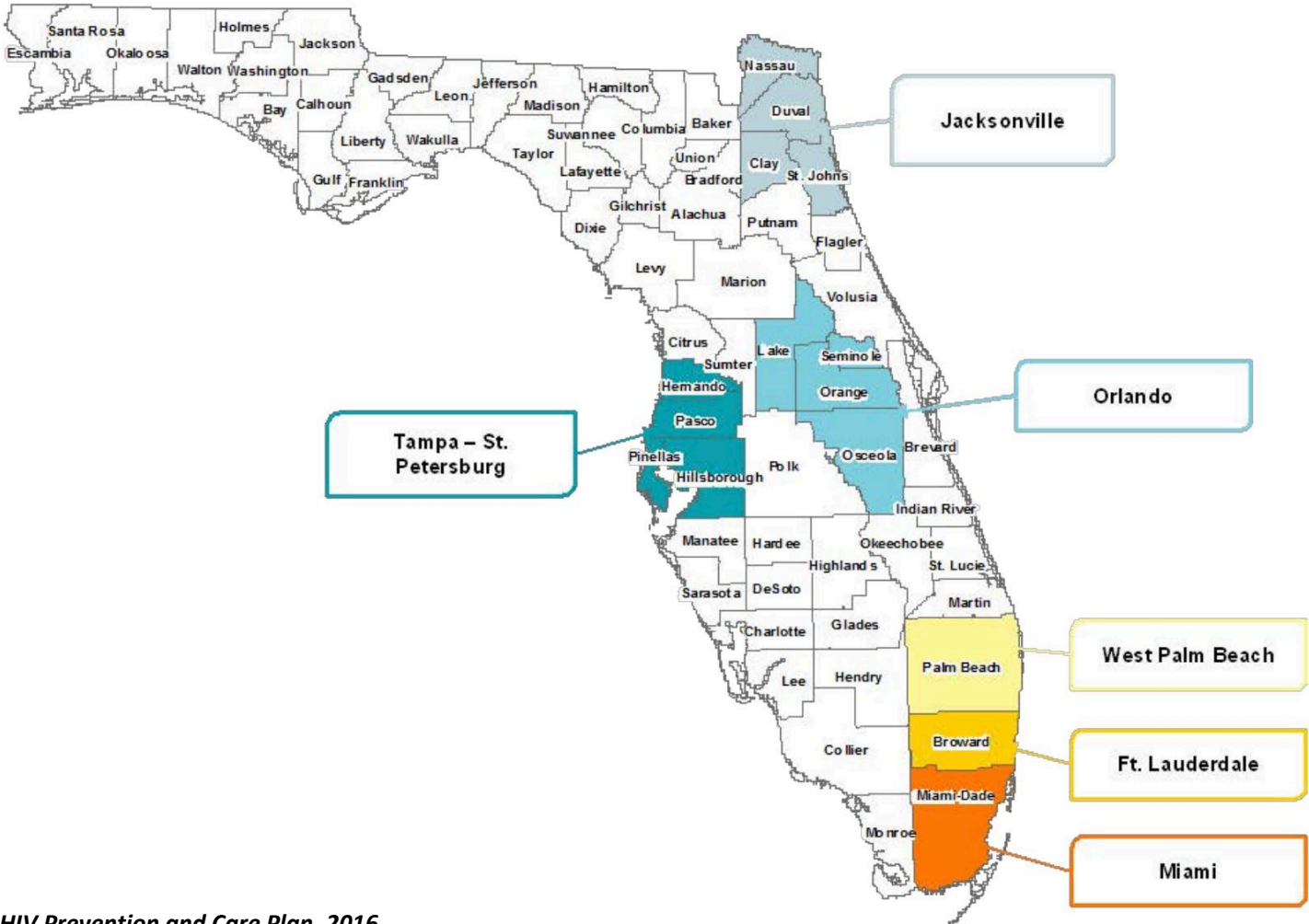

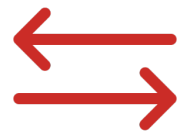

People move in and out of the state, as well as within the state, potentially moving between Ryan White service areas

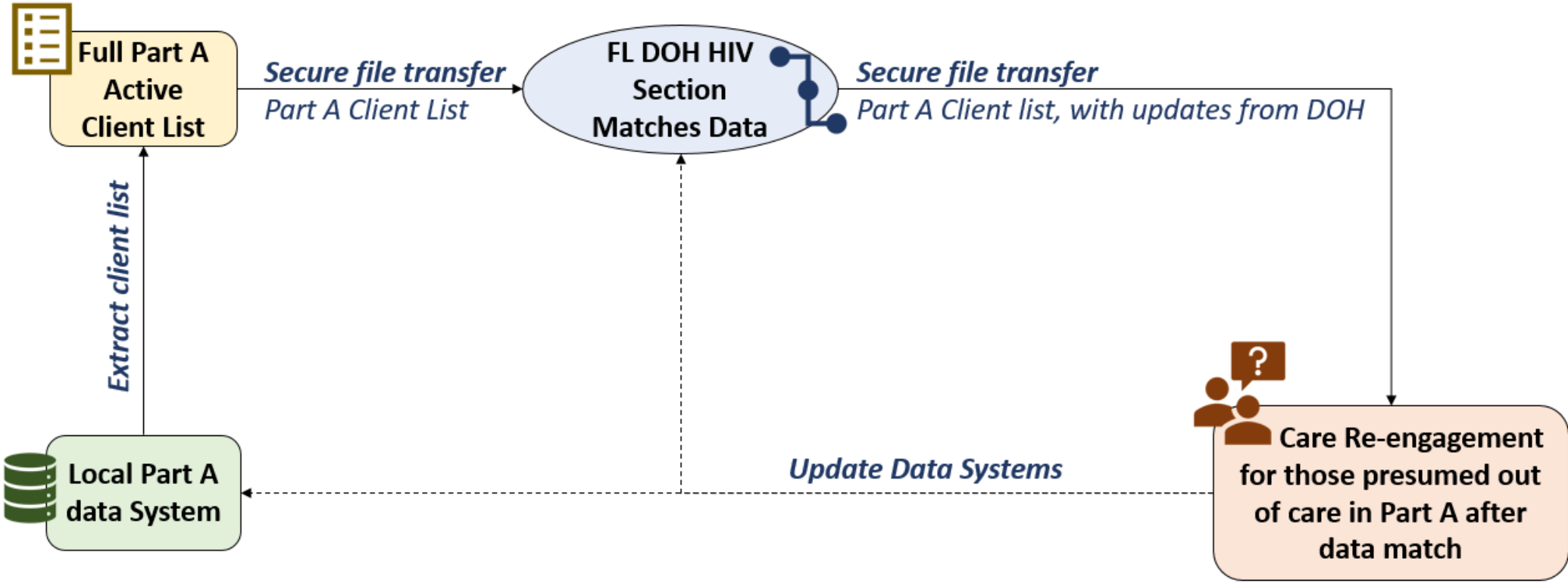


RWPA programs are not DOH staff – meaning the state is not able to share data with the Part A programs under state surveillance authority



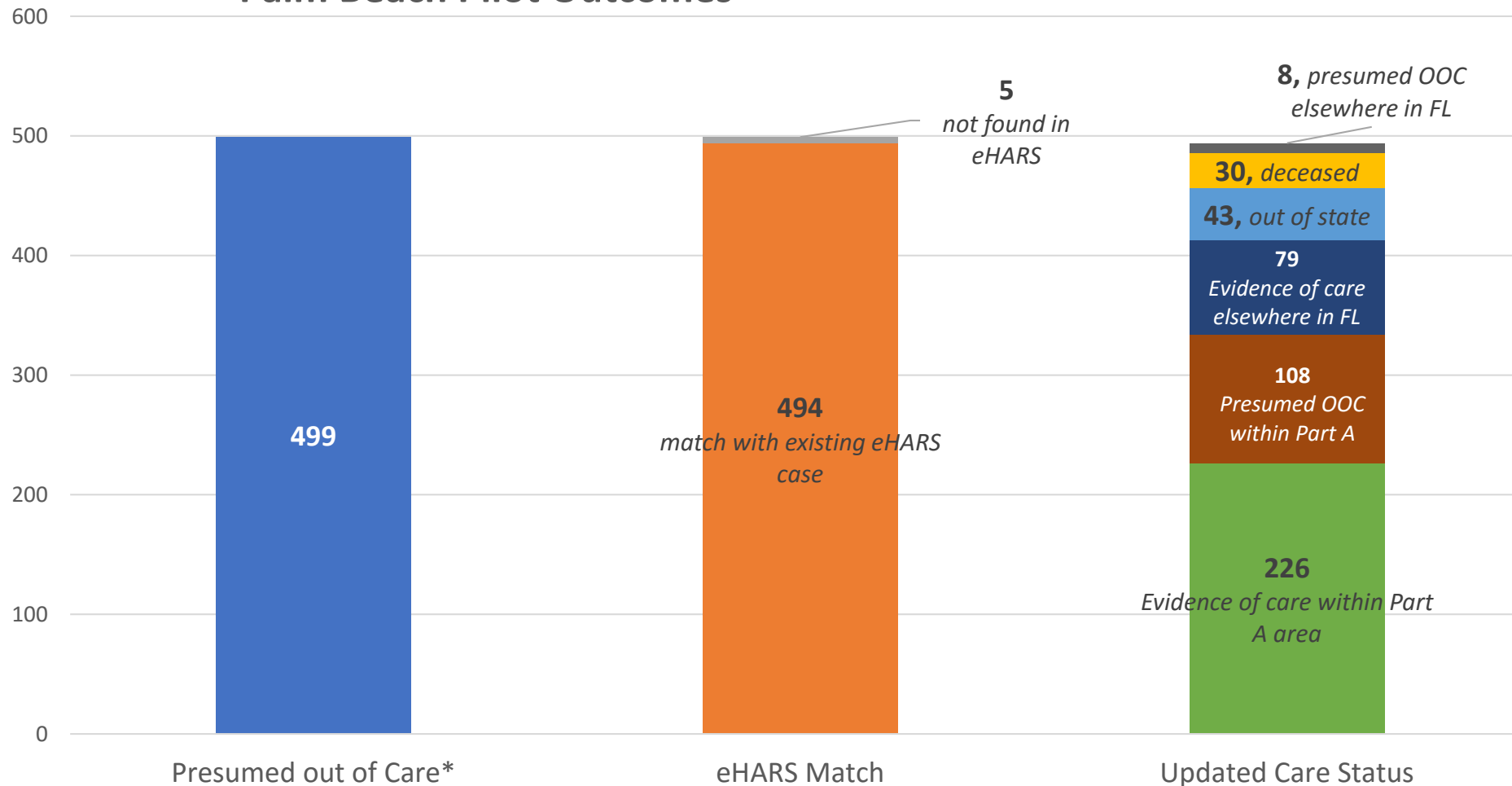
RWPA programs have incomplete data regarding their current and prior clients

Routine Data Matches Allow for more Optimized Care Engagement



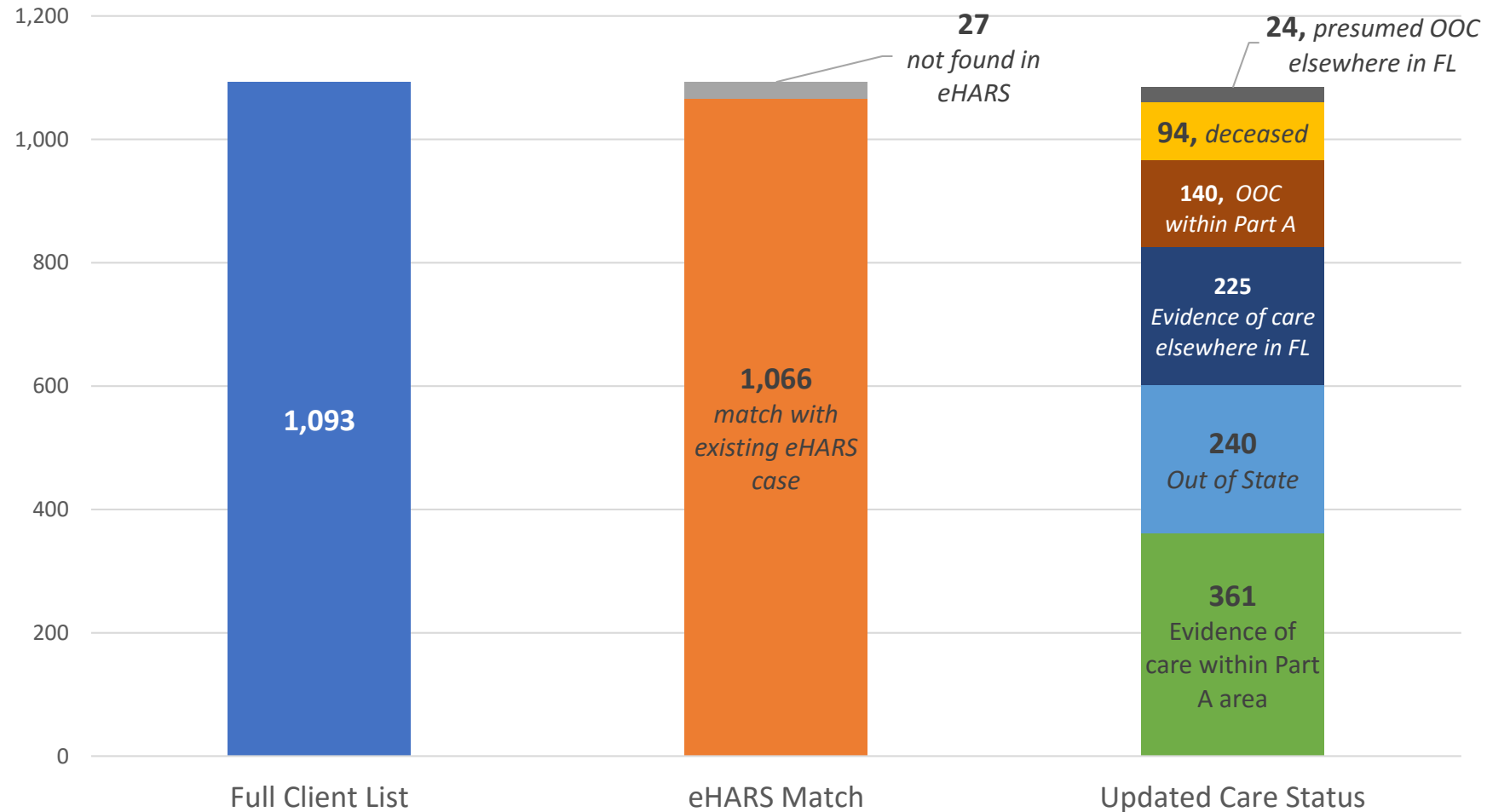
Preliminary Outcomes of Pilot Data Matches

Palm Beach Pilot Outcomes



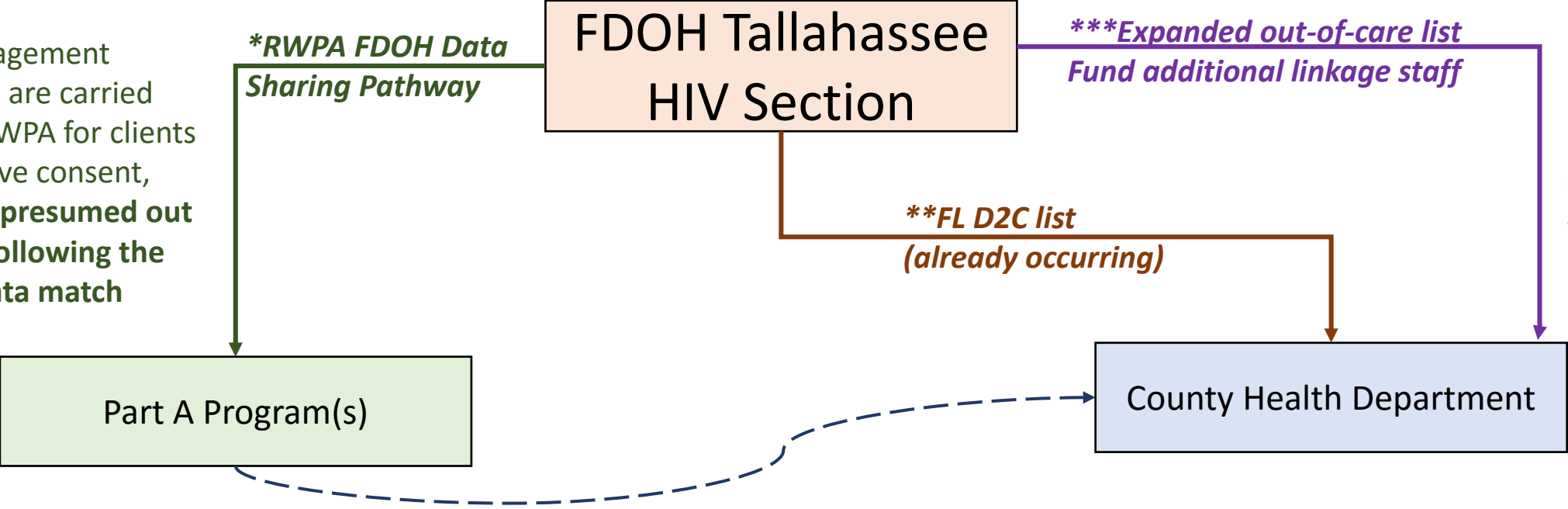

Plan for Data Sharing Enhancement and Widespread Client Re-engagement

*Re-engagement activities are carried out by RWPA for clients with active consent, who are **presumed out of care** following the FDOH data match



***FDOH expands the number of clients sent to the CHD, to **begin serving the larger OOC population** in Florida.

Current CHD capacity means that **less than 1% of the full FL OOC population is sent to the CHD for follow up each month.
