Our WORK-A Brief Overview

- Supportive Housing demonstration project geared toward WLHV with children.
- WLHV can have a residency for up to three years, requiring them to attend school or job training.
- The project will provide wraparound services to support stability.
- Develop by Women Living with HIV, and will be Peer Lead
- Supported by the Michigan Department of Health & Human Services HIV Care & Prevention Division and the City of Detroit Health Department-Ending the Epidemic Initiative

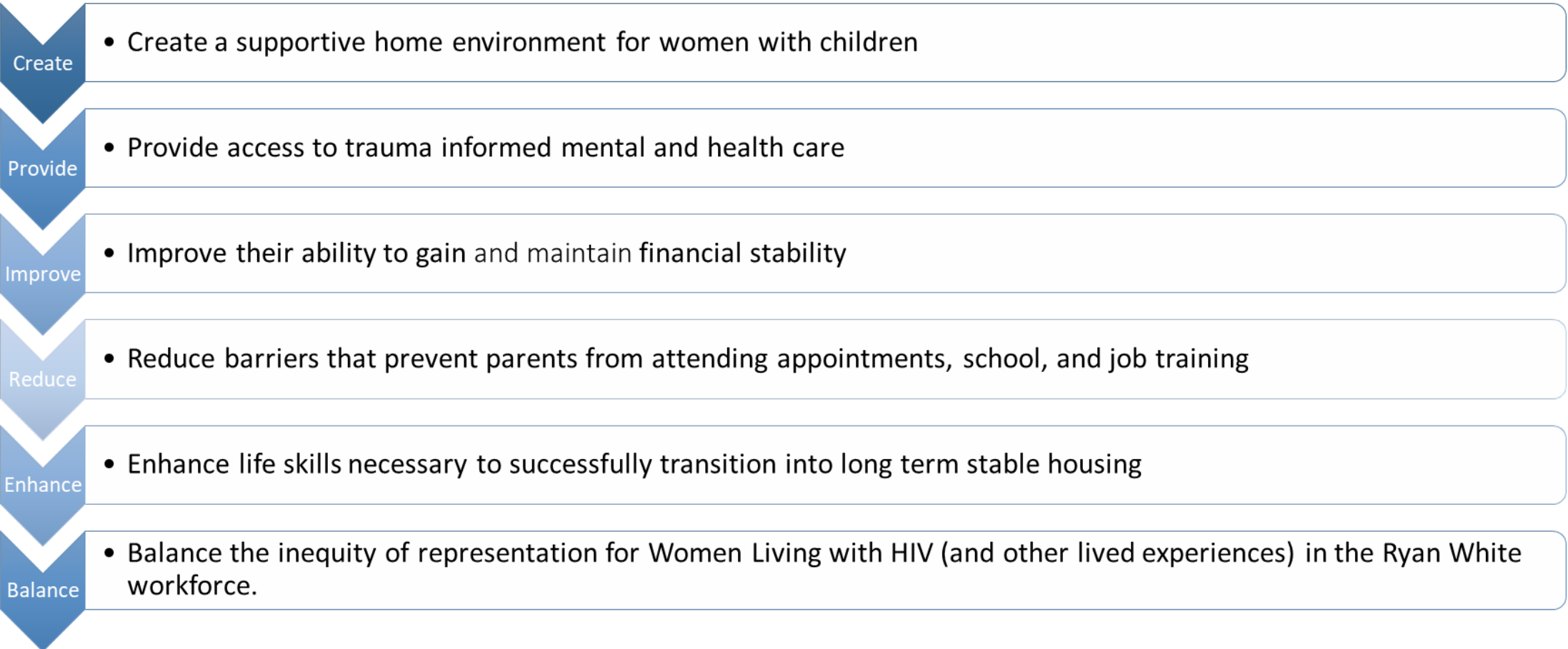

Project Goals



Our WORK Core & Supportive Services

- **Outpatient Ambulatory Health Services (OAHS)**
 - Medical care and treatment can be provided on-site or off-site
 - Option to have medical insurance from the insurance exchange to support program income
- **Mental Health Services**
 - Individual trauma-informed care provided by a licensed therapist
 - Eligible for services based on the degree of trauma being unpacked.
 - Psychosocial Support services through the collaboration of therapist and LMSW
- **Transportation**
 - Residents will be supported with transportation to and from job training as well as other specialty care appointments
- **Childcare**
 - Children will receive childcare off-site during regular business hours, and when appropriate, on-site support will be provided after regular business hours
- **Food Bank/Home Delivered Meals**
 - Will assist with supplementing hygiene items and cleaning supplies for family units
