

## Performance Measures and the HIVQM - Written Q & A Summary

#	Questions	Answers
1.	Where do we login to see the HIVQM data?	Recipients and subrecipients can access the HIV Quality Measures (HIVQM) Module in the <a href="#">RSR Web System</a> through their most recent RSR deliverable. Once in the RSR Provider Report Inbox, click on the HIVQM Inbox link on the bottom of the lefthand navigation panel. If data has been entered in the system, go to the Reports section to see other types of data reports. Please reach out to <a href="#">RWHAP Data Support</a> if you need any assistance accessing the HIVQM.
2.	Which report do you run in CAREWare to get the import file?	The report is within the Performance Measures portion. We recommend reviewing CAREWare's <a href="#">HIVQM Setup Instructions</a> or reaching out to the <a href="#">CAREWare Help Desk</a> for additional guidance.
3.	Is the HIVQM a required report?	The HIVQM is a voluntary tool. You choose whether to use it and which performance measures you would like to monitor.
4.	Can a recipient run the associated reports for each of their subrecipients?	Yes. Recipients can enter and run reports on each of their subrecipients.
5.	If I'm updating data in March, and I also want to update the module with data from periods that I had not input previously, could I do that in the same input or would I need to do a separate import?	During the March submission period, only 1 CSV is needed to update/add any data to all past reporting periods. Please refer to the <a href="#">HIVQM Instruction Manual</a> for additional information.
6.
