ClASS: Goals

- Determine transition readiness by assessing administrative, clinical, and financial capacity of USG-supported HIV/AIDS programs
- Inform HRSA and partners of existing technical assistance needs and identify available resources to address needs
- Support successful and sustainable transition of programs to local leadership

Objectives (1)

- Ensure that organizational systems, policies, and procedures are in place to accomplish program goals and objectives;
- Assess the organization's capacity to provide the funded services and manage funding;
- Identify program strengths/weaknesses and provide appropriate consultation;

Objectives (2)

- Specify areas of system strengthening to enable organization to enhance and sustain their HIV service delivery; and
- Assess organization readiness to fully assume prime or other roles supporting local treatment facilities to provide high quality health care and services.


