Charges to Clients

- Publicly available fee scale
- Annual cap on charges- calendar year
- Based on charges imposed
- Individuals
- Annual gross income

Annual Cap on Charges

- Must be tracked
- No charges ≤100% Federal Poverty Level (FPL)
- Will charge >100% FPL
- No more than % of annual gross income-
- 101-200% FPL 5%
- 201-300% FPL 7%
- 301+% FPL 10%

What is Program Income?

- Program income is any income that is generated for a grantee or subcontractor by the grant or earned as a result of the grant.
- This includes charges to beneficiaries under the sliding scale, as well as reimbursements from Medicaid, Medicare, and private insurance for services provided.
