Requested that HHS address pressing concerns about implementation and coverage for persons with HIV under the new Medicare Modernization Act.

Advice on Budget and Services

Recommend HIV/AIDS care services in expanded Community Health Centers

Expressed concern about flat funding, impact on rescissions, and needed additional funds for ADAP

Established new STD workgroup to focus on Syphilis elimination and HPV vaccine issues and STD racial disparities

Convened workgroup to develop recommendations Held 3 public hearings in 2003 (L.A., Miami, D.C.)
Over 430 attendees;
received 103 oral and 80 written testimonies.

Recommendations submitted to Sec. Thompson (2004)

Resubmitted to Sec. Leavitt (2005)

Responded to President's Principles Nov. 2005

Passed New Motion in May 2006

Ryan White CARE Act 2009 Reauthorization

Convened workgroup in May 2008 to discuss development of reauthorization recommendations for 2009

Held conference calls to discuss potential recommendations

Adopted recommendations

Ryan Workgroup on Future of Health Care Reform and the Possible Impacts on HIV Services

Established May 2009

Held 15 webinars and conference calls with invited speakers

Reported to CHAC – May 2010
