

Gender Identity is an individuals internal understanding of their gender. **Everyone has a gender identity.**


Factors influencing data collection and quality



If/How somebody is asked about their gender identity

- Culture of the local agency
- Comfort level and competency of the staff asking the question
- Comfort level of the client in answering the question

How that information is entered into the data collection system





Where do we collect gender identity among PLWH

- 2014 Texas HIV Surveillance System began collecting gender identity on the HIV Case Report Form (CRF)
- Routine matches with other data sources
 - Ryan White (ARIES, HIV2000)
 - Prevention (STD*MIS)
 - Medical Monitoring Project (Texas and Houston MMP)
- Medical Record Abstraction
 - When data sources have conflicting information




Transgender PLWH, Texas 2014-2018






New HIV Diagnoses, Texas 2009-2018






HIV Treatment Cascade for Transgender Women, 2018















2015 U.S. Transgender Survey






27,715 respondents to an anonymous online survey for transgender adults

Assessed and identified disparate outcomes related to:

- Discrimination
- Stigma
- Violence
- Employment
- Education
- Accessing medical services

2019 – The Grapevine: A Southern Trans Report





What are the top issues impacting and motivating Transgender and Gender Non-binary people in your community?



44%

of participants identified primary care and HIV-inclusive health care as the top issue that impacts their community and that they would be interested in motivating to change.



21%

of participants identified law enforcement accountability as the top issue that impacts their community. ⁷ I cannot stress more how important and nonexistent basic health care is.

E-mail USTS Report to colleagues

Schedule staff in-service on transgender cultural humility

Create transgender wellness clinic

Watch online training on how to ask SOGI questions

Update language in policies to be affirming of different gender identities

Work with surveillance staff to create forms/databases/processes that are reflecting of all gender identities
