

Provider Summaries

- Upon login, shows important provider rates for any performance measures
- Shows how rates change over time
- Provides hyperlinks to clients who do and don't meet the measure
- Design flexibility allows users to select colors, fonts, etc.








Client Summaries

- Upon login, shows important changes over time for labs/vital signs of interest
- Design flexibility allows users to
 - change date range,
 - add demographic info;
 - select colors, fonts, etc.







Streamlined data imports

- Consolidate data import functions in CAREWare
 - All mappings of imported values will be located in place, regardless of the type of file being imported (PDI, HL-7, CSV)
- Building tools to import from any major source with a known format
- Will include pre-mapped fields for major electronic Clinical Quality Measures (eCQMs)
 that are part of the Bureau of Primary Care's Uniform Data System PLS
 - Covering major codesets such as ICD-10, SNOMED, CPT, LOINC, RxNorm
 - Codes from these inputs will be mapped to native CAREWare coding for ease of use
