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Background

The Ryan White (RW) HIV/AIDS Client-Level Data (CLD) Report provides demographic and HIV care outcome information on all clients receiving RW services.

The Ending the HIV Epidemic (EHE): A Plan for America initiative aims to address the HIV epidemic locally in high incidence areas.

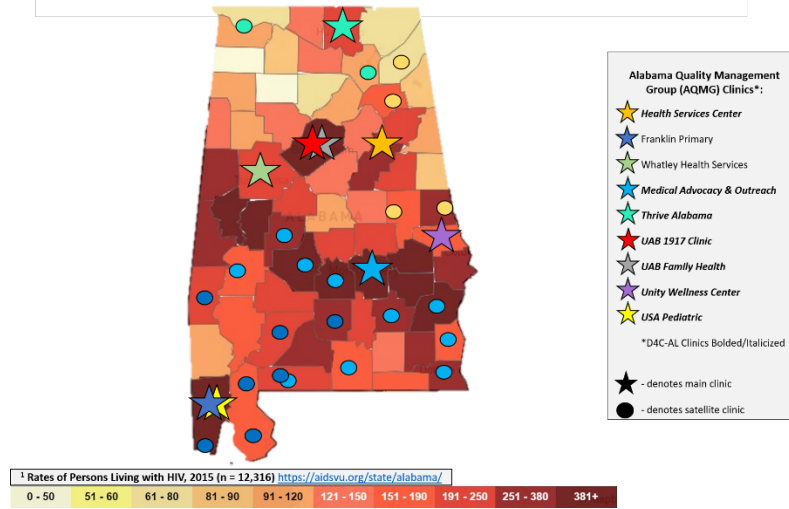

GOAL:
75% reduction in new HIV infections in 5 years and at least 90% reduction in 10 years.

ENDING THE HIV EPIDEMIC: A PLAN FOR AMERICA

- Diagnose HIV as early as possible
- Treat HIV quickly and effectively
- Protect people at risk
- Respond quickly to clusters of new cases

Method

Since 2018, 7 of 9 Alabama Quality Management Group (AQMG) Ryan White Part C and D Clinics began reporting quarterly CLD based on RW Program Services Report (RSR) to help inform Alabama's HIV epidemic based on >80% of Alabama's diagnosed HIV population.

Future Directions

With CLD on 8,500 unduplicated patients, the AQMG through the CDC/Alabama Department of Public Health (ADPH) Data for Care-Alabama project is equipped to analyze trends in new diagnoses and HIV outcomes among urban and rural areas at close to real time.
