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Vision: Healthy Communities, Healthy People



Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Overview

- Supports more than 90 programs that provide health care to people who are geographically isolated, economically or medically vulnerable through grants and cooperative agreements to more than 3,000 awardees, including community and faith-based organizations, colleges and universities, hospitals, state, local, and tribal governments, and private entities
- Every year, HRSA programs serve tens of millions of people, including people with HIV/AIDS, pregnant women, mothers and their families, and those otherwise unable to access quality health care





HRSA's HIV/AIDS Bureau (HAB) Vision and Mission

Vision

Optimal HIV/AIDS care and treatment for all.

Mission

Provide leadership and resources to assure access to and retention in high quality, integrated care, and treatment services for vulnerable people with HIV/AIDS and their families.





HRSA's Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program

- Provides comprehensive system of HIV primary medical care, medications, and essential support services for low-income people with HIV
 - More than half of people with diagnosed HIV in the United States nearly 519,000 people receive care through the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP)
- Funds grants to states, cities/counties, and local community based organizations
 - Recipients determine service delivery and funding priorities based on local needs and planning process
- Payor of last resort statutory provision: RWHAP funds may not be used for services if another state or federal payer is available
- 87.1% of Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program clients were virally suppressed in 2018, exceeding national average of 62.7%



Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program

Treatment Modernization Act of 2006

Title XXVI of the Public Health Service (PHS) Act (Public Law 109-415,

December 19, 2006)

All Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program recipients are required "to establish clinical quality management programs to:

Measure

Assess the extent to which HIV health services are consistent with the most recent Public Health Service guidelines for the treatment of HIV disease and related opportunistic infections;

Improvement

Develop strategies for ensuring that such services are consistent with the guidelines for improvement in the access to and quality of HIV services"





Clinical Quality Management (CQM) Policy Clarification Notice 15-02

Purpose:

This policy clarification notice (PCN) is to clarify the Health Resources and Services Administration Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program expectations for clinical quality management programs.

Originally released in September 2015 and revised/re-released in November 2018

RWHAP Parts A, B, C, and D Recipients and Subrecipients

Components of a CQM Program

A CQM program is the coordination of activities aimed at improving patient care, health outcomes, and patient satisfaction.


CQM activities should be continuous and fit within and support the framework of grant administration functions.





Components of a CQM Program



Leadership Roles and Responsibilities



- Guiding CQM program develop
- Providing information to incorporate into the CQM program
- Endorsing CQM program activities
- Championing or promoting CQM program
- Raising the visibility of the CQM program and activities

Dedicated Staffing

- Person(s) who are responsible for the day-to-day implementation of the CQM program
 - Development and implementation of CQM program
 - Knowledge and skills in CQM methodologies
 - Often referred to as the Quality Manager or CQM Coordinator
- May be one or more people depending on the size of the RWHAP grant
 - May be a full time equivalent or a portion of a full time equivalent
- May consist of recipient staff or contractors

CQM Committee's Purpose


The CQM committee develops the CQM program and corresponding activities

- Strategic planning for the CQM program
- Oversee the CQM program implementation
- Provides guidance and reassurances





CQM Committee's Activities



CQM committee activities include:

- Advise on the direction of the CQM program
 - new and recurring CQM program activities
- Discuss CQM program process and help resolve barriers
- Provide feedback on the CQM plan
- Review, discuss, and plan for use of PM data





CQM Committee's Membership

- Recipient's Quality Manager
- Recipient leadership
- Recipient staff involved with data management and analysis
- ADAP director (if a Part B program)
- Recipient staff overseeing RWHAP services
- People with HIV
- Subrecipients
- RWHAP leaders from other Parts
- Others






CQM Committee Models

- One CQM committee with recipient staff only
- One CQM committee with recipient staff and external stakeholders
- Two CQM committee
 - One CQM committee with recipient staff only
 - One CQM committee with recipient staff and external stakeholders
- Two CQM committee
 - RWHAP specific CQM committee
 - Organization wide CQM committee
- Other blended models
 - As long as recipient has a CQM committee for the RWHAP

Dedicated Resources

Dedicated resources is funding for building capacity in order to carry out CQM activities



Technical assistance and capacity development to subrecipients



Collecting performance measure data



CQM Training for dedicated staff, CQM committee, people with HIV, and stakeholders





Why Involve People with HIV in the CQM Program?


People with HIV involvement ensures:

- CQM program activities reflect the population being served and services provided
 - <u>Example</u>: Stratify performance measure data based on the subpopulations served by the recipient
- The needs of people with HIV are being addressed by CQM program
 <u>Example</u>: Incorporate needs of people with HIV in the development of QI projects

Involvement of Stakeholders

People who provide input on CQM activities to be undertaken, could coordinate CQM activities, and share information about the CQM program

- People who will implement CQM activities
- People who manage CQM programs in the service area
- People who are experts in a particular field and could advise on a particular CQM activity (e.g., dentist who could advise on a PM)


Stakeholders could be members of the CQM committee or provide ad hoc input

CQM Plan Purpose and Components

Describes all aspects of the CQM program including:

- Priorities and goals
- Infrastructure
- Performance measures
- QI activities
- Action plan or work plan with a timeline and responsible parties
- Evaluation of the CQM program

CQM plan is a written document and is reviewed and revised annual






EHE Language for CQM Budgeting

Ending the HIV Epidemic: A Plan for America (EHE) — Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Parts A and B Notice of Funding Opportunity (HRSA 20-078) states


- HRSA expects that the recipient will coordinate initiative CQM activities with their existing RWHAP CQM Program
- Recipients may, but are not required to allocate up to 5% of the total grant award for CQM

Evaluation of CQM Program: Overview

- Evaluation includes assessing whether CQM program activities have been implemented as prescribed by the CQM plan (including the action plan)
- Recipients should include regular evaluation of their CQM activities in order to maximize the impact of the program
- Part of the evaluation should include:
 - Identifying CQM program components to sustain, change, remove, and adopt
 - Assessing the effectiveness of the team
 - The teams ability to meet timelines and deliverables as described in the action plan in order to determine the success of the planned process



How to Evaluate the CQM Program?

- Assess each goal, objective, and action step in the work plan
 - Were the goals, objectives, and action steps completed? What are the reasons it was not completed?
 - What was the effect of completing?
 - Should we add the activity to next year's CQM plan?
 - What new activities should be add to next year's CQM plan based on the current activities?
 - Which activities should be scaled up or spread?
- Facilitate a discussion with the CQM committee to ask the above questions
 - Use the last CQM committee meeting of the year before you revised the CQM plan






