




Introduction



- Pittsburgh Area Center for Treatment (PACT) has served people living with HIV in 11 county area of southwestern Pennsylvania since 1985
- Caseload: ~1600
- PACT is part of UPMC, the largest health system in Pennsylvania
- Patient records are maintained in Epic and posted to CAREWare, an RSR-ready system
- This poster demonstrates how Epic reports are used to build files that can be imported into CAREWare:
 - Cross-reference tables and a provider table are used to convert Epic labs and services to CAREWare format
 - Importing 80% of our data from Epic to CAREWare saves over 30 hours of manual work per month



Epic Labs Report



- Criteria established for Labs for the Epic lab report include:
 - Patient is anyone seen at PACT in the previous 2 years
 - Labs can be ordered by any department within UPMC, not just PACT
 - Patient labs are reported if they are resulted in the two-week period contained in the report
 - Image on the right shows a slice of the Labs import file

- Cross-reference table lists Epic lab descriptions with matching CAREWare test descriptions.
 - Table is manually updated during the import process to reflect new Epic labs and their CAREWare equivalents
 - Epic labs that do not have a CAREWare equivalent are not assigned a CAREWare test ID number.
 - Image on the right shows Epic matches for a CAREWare Viral Load

Test Limits Table



- Limits table contains Epic lab result phrases and their numeric CAREWare equivalents
 - Table is manually updated when Epic lab results are changed
 - Image on the right shows results for a Viral Load
 - Matching result is posted to the output table in Comma Separated Value (CSV) format
 - Epic labs are converted to CAREWare format in about 10 seconds

Services



- Automated process is limited to services that can be easily processed for CAREWare including:
 - HIV Primary Medical Care
 - Mental Health Services
 - Nutrition Therapy Services
 - Peer Advocate
- Services report from Epic for a calendar month
- Provider Table that includes staff that performs
 ONE of the above services is used
- Insurance and patient demographic data is included to allocate service to correct contract (Part C, Part D, or Insured Visits)

- Only completed visits are included
- Services NOT imported, requiring manual data entry, include:
 - Medical Case Management
 - Case Management (non-medical)
 - RW Part B funded services
 - Program Income funded services
- Case Managers can address any number of issues in one encounter, so our abstractor reads the notes and parses them to CAREWare sub-services

CAREWare DTM and PDI



CAREWare Data Translation Module (DTM)

- DTM is configured to read a specific file format
- Tests and services are run using separate options and at separate times
- DTM converts from Comma Separated Value (CSV)
 to CAREWare Provider Data Import (PDI) format
- DTM and PDI are proven capabilities

CAREWare PDI to import tests and services

- Go to Administrative Options
- Select Import/Export
- Select Provider Data Import
- Select New Import
- Select the file you want
- Import the file to the CAREWare holding area
- Process the import
- Use Import Details to track progress
- Manually scroll between pages to reset displayed values
