

Frequently Asked Questions for FY 2020 and 2021 Reporting Requirements Overview Webinar

Q1: The service category table/care continuum table is not available in EHB and the template is not downloadable.

Answer: TargetHIV will contain this attachment including all other applicable materials. Templates will also be available in EHB in the Annual Progress Report (APR) submission section.

Q2: Will this webinar be recorded so it can be accessed at a later time?

Answer: The webinar is not recorded but presentation slides and all provided materials are available on TargetHIV website.

Q3: Is the expenditure report a new format and different from previous years? Also, is this the first time this format is being used?

Answer: The expenditure report was previously a document uploaded in EHB as a submission. Starting this year, it is a form that is populated within the PTR system enhancing recipient submission processing.

Q4: How do we populate the EHE approved carryover amount in the expenditure report? It is my understanding that our requests for carryover are submitted with the FFR in July?

Answer: FY 20 is the first year of EHE, therefore there is no carryover to report in the FY 20 Expenditure Report. Carryover expenditures from FY 20 into FY 21 will be reported on the FY 21 Expenditure Report due in May 2022.

Q5: In the EHE expenditure report, is there a section for initiative services and infrastructure?

Answer: Yes, there is a section in the document for reporting those expenditures.
