1. What advice do you have for organizations that have never applied to HRSA NOFOs before? What advice do you have for organization that have been through other federal government review processes? How might HRSA's processes be different from others? What should organizations prepare when applying to the HRSA NOFO?

The biggest piece of advice is to read the NOFO and the SF-424 Application Guide carefully and follow instructions. Also, in your application, please align your headings to the headings in the Project Narrative (page 19-29), so that it's easy for the objective review committee to see that you've addressed all sections of the review criteria.

2. How will you review applications from organization that have never worked with HRSA before? In the pre-application webinar, it states that HRSA will consider past performance in managing contracts, grants, and/or cooperative agreements of a similar size, scope, and complexity.

Applicants don't need to have previous experience working with HRSA. All applications regardless of the organization's experience level with HRSA cooperative agreements or grants will be equally reviewed and rated based on the review criteria in Section V of the NOFO.
