#	Questions	Answers
1.	Why do we continue to gather CD4s when they are no longer being used by physicians as readily or consistently?	CD4s are still part of clinical care so they are included in the ADR reporting requirements. HAB understands that CD4s are being ordered less frequently by clinicians and that you may have more missing data. If you receive a validation message for missing CD4s dates and counts, you can indicate in your validation comment if the reason is that the tests are not being ordered as often.
2.	Is there any information available yet on how recertification data will be changed because of PCN 21-02?	There is not any new guidance regarding the data requirements for recertification as a result <a href="#">PCN 21-02</a> . Any updated guidance will be shared through our <a href="#">DISQ ADR email listserv</a> and during <a href="#">upcoming webinars</a> .
3.	Is it possible to get ADR changes and validations sooner in the year?	DISQ will share this feedback with HAB. Changes in reporting or validations will be shared as soon as they are available.
