If this is a new provider or you did not fund them in previous years, they may not be listed there. 5.	Can you please repeat where we should enter administrative and technical services?	Funding amounts for administrative and technical services are not entered into the GCMS and are instead entered directly into the PTR/Allocations Report in the Allocations table. For additional resources related to the PTR/Allocations Report, check out the PTR/Allocations Report subtopic page on the TargetHIV website.
6.	If we are the recipient of a RWHAP Part C grant, and a subrecipient of a RWHAP Part B grant, should we add under our contract the services provided using RWHAP Part B funds under the RW related funds column?	You only have to enter services for the grant for which you are a recipient (RWHAP Part C). The RWHAP Part B grant recipient will enter your organization under their contracts. For more information about recipient and subrecipient relationships, please refer to page 2 in the GCMS Instruction Manual. In addition, RWHAP base grants are not
		considered RWHAP-related funding. Only program income and pharmaceutical rebates are considered RWHAP-related services. For more
