#	Questions	Answers
1.	For determining whether a client is new, does that refer to a new diagnosis or new to the provider agency?	Report a client as “new” if they are new to your agency. This would include all clients with new diagnoses because they are new to receiving HIV care at your agency. Clients who were previously diagnosed and are new to your agency are also reported as new.
2.	We have a Part D program at our hospital, and clients are transitioned into our program when they age out of Part D. Should these individuals be reported as new clients?	Report a client as “new” if they are new to receiving HIV care at your program. If your agency has another operationally separate program, the client would be considered new to your program if they transition in.
