

ADR Town Hall - Written Q & A Summary

#	Questions	Answers
1.	When will this year's ADR outreach calls be held?	<p>The DISQ Team is conducting two stages of outreach. First, we identified ADAPs that had data quality issues that would require process changes that would take longer to implement. We've already reached out to those ADAPs as part of summer outreach. Second, we'll be conducting fall outreach which is anticipated to begin in November 2024. As we do each year, we'll be creating the ADR Summary Reports based on your most recent ADR submission. Do you want to meet before November? You don't have to wait for the DISQ Team to contact you-you can contact us at data.ta@caiglobal.org if you're ready to meet to discuss your 2023 submission and plan for the 2024 ADR.</p>
2.	How do other ADAPs identify clients with LIS so they can accurately note them as a partial premium payment?	<p>ADAPs are required to differentiate between full and partial health insurance premiums as part of the ADR submission. This question is specific to identifying clients who receive a Medicare Part D Low Income Subsidy (LIS) which would be reported as a partial premium. The health insurance premium statement that an ADAP receives may not always include whether or not they receive a subsidy.</p> <p>The DISQ Team highlighted the ADR In Focus: Partial Premiums as a possible resource that may be helpful. Several ADAPs also shared suggestions that included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Request that Insurance Benefits Manager (IBM) track as part of enrollment (Wyoming ADAP) • Compare a client's income with the subsidy requirement for your state. While this is not a perfect approach, it can be helpful. (Colorado ADAP)
3.	When do you recommend we get started on our ADR?	<p>If you are new to the ADR, we recommend that you reach out to DISQ Team as soon as feasible. If you don't have documentation about your approach or roles and responsibilities, you can also start on that now. In terms of the actual 2024 ADR submission, we suggest you start as soon as you can (and before the actual submission opens) to ensure that you have the needed</p>

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		programmatic, fiscal and client-level data. The timing of this may be impacted by your data availability, so be sure that your Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM)/Pharmacy, Insurance Benefit Manager (IBM) and other vendors know your data needs and timeline. Feel free to contact the DISQ Team to start planning for the 2024 ADR submission-it's never too soon!
