- PT Project started September 2015 in FY1
- Intent:
  - To increase the size and strength of the HIV clinical workforce and to improve outcomes along the HIV Care Continuum
- Goal:
  - To transform selected clinical practices and to build the capacity of the selected organizations to provide quality, comprehensive care and treatment to PLWH as evidenced by progress along the HIV Care Continuum
