NJ CPC and H4C



- NJCPC had statewide participation in the In Care Campaign.
- Quarterly meetings to discuss successes and challenges and determine ways to help providers succeed.
- Strengthened our partnership with surveillance.
- Produced HIV Continua for the entire State, Ryan White vs. non-Ryan White funded, planning regions and individual clinics.
- Successfully moved 1068 consumers to viral suppression as part of the H4C Cohort Study.

Offers:

- 1) Ongoing communication with agencies (local and out of state) about how we collaborate to meet the demands of H4C participation.
- 2) NJ Buddy System- we will share how we build capacity by focusing on accuracy of data in one on one sessions at agencies with minimal or no additional administrative support to understand measurement definitions and complete these reports

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
